# **Entries:**

All entries must be submitted on Regatta Central, <a href="https://www.regattacentral.com">https://www.regattacentral.com</a>, between April 14, 2015.

Entry fees\* must be paid online. If unable to pay online, please contact Deanna Wilkinson at wilkinsondb@comcast.net or 616-485-4348

### NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Teams not paid in full will not be allowed to launch.

Your entries must include:

- 1. **Eligibility list** certifying student's eligibility **and grade**. This information must be typed on a form sanctioned by your state **or** on your high school stationery, and signed by your athletic director or principal. Handwritten lists are **not** acceptable.
- US Rowing Waiver (copies of signed waivers are sufficient). This should be completed on Regatta Central.
- 3. Entry fees

The omission of any of the items listed above will disqualify your entry.

# Rules:

- An oarsperson may enter a maximum of 2 events (coxswains excluded).
- A minimum of 3 entries must be received in order for a race to be run.
- Weigh-Ins: No weigh-ins will be held, but we expect coaches to follow these guidelines:

WOMEN: Lightweight 130lb MAX MEN: Lightweight 150lb MAX

- Junior Oarsman: May be a Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior in high school.
- Novice Oarsman: First year of high school rowing, regardless of rowing experience.

# **Heats:**

All heats are 1,000 meters. You will be notified prior to the regatta if you have heats. Heats will run before finals. In events where heats are necessary, every effort will be made to allow for athlete recuperation.

# Medals:

Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes as follows:

- Events with **five or more crews** gold medals and silver and bronze ribbons will be awarded.
- Events with **four crews** gold medals and silver ribbons will be awarded.
- Events with **three crews** only gold medals will be awarded.
- Every member of a medal/ribbon-winning crew will receive a medal/ribbon.
- Medals/ribbons will not be awarded for the 500 Meter Dash events.

# **Team Trophies:**

The Don and Claudia LeBlanc Men's and Women's Team trophies will again be awarded based on the following point system:

Eights: 9 points for 1<sup>st</sup> 4 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> 2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> Fours: 5 points for 1<sup>st</sup> 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> 1 point for 3<sup>rd</sup>

Doubles & Singles: No points
