LAKE NATOMA MASTERS 1000 METER RACE

Races will be conducted by the Sacramento State Aquatic Center on the premier rowing venue, Lake Natoma. Rowers will go for the **gold** (silver and bronze), as the miners did in 1849, on a 1000 meter fully buoyed course with stake boats.

ELIGIBILITY:

A "Master" shall be defined by USRowing rules of racing for 2010. A Masters' crew shall be comprised exclusively of Master rowers. The coxswain need not be a Master. The age category of a **Masters crew shall be determined by the average age of the rowers in the crew, rounded down to the nearest integer.** The age of the coxswain shall not be counted. "AA" (age 21-26) entries shall follow USRowing rules of racing for 2010 thus shall have no other restrictions.

REGATTA SCHEDULE:

FISA race format will be used. All races within an event will be condensed to minimum intervals. All crew must be accomplished in staging quickly onto a start platform. Static refereeing will be used for all boats with coxswains. Events with less than three entries will either be eliminated or run concurrently with another events. A tentative schedule will be posted May12. Equipment borrowing is the athletes' responsibility. An 8 lane race course will be used. When events have multiple races, each race is a "medal race"... no joint final.

Please provide <u>your own</u> bow numbers. USRowing rules for safety will be followed. Bow balls and heel tie downs or quick-release shoes are required. Please lock onto the start 2 minutes prior to start of race, or penalty will be given at the discretion of the judge/referee.

Coaches and coxswains' meeting will be held at the finish line at 7:00 a.m., May 22, 2010.

Weigh-ins for lightweights will be at the finish line between 7:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Coxswains need not weigh in.

Start Time for the first race is 9:00 a.m.

Reverse handicapping will be used with handicaps assigned at the start. The first to cross the finish line will hold the gold medal place. False starts will result in disqualification. No protests and NO WHINING.

Lightweights: Men = 160 lbs Women = 130 lbs maximum Coxswains = NO weigh-ins

Competition Description

Overall crew ranking is not determined on the basis of heats, repechages, semi-finals or finals. If entries exceed the number of racing lanes (8) in any event, as many races as necessary are added to the event, with a medal awarded to the winner of each race.

AGE CATEGORIES FOR HANDICAPPING:

"Competing against rowers of similar age is an incentive to participate." FISA

Age categories are as follows:

AA – Minimum age - 21 A - Average age 27 or more B - Average age 36 or more C - Average age 43 or more D - Average age 50 or more E - Average age 55 or more F - Average age 60 or more G - Average age 65 or more H - Average age 70 or more I - Average age 75 or more

J - Average age 80 or more



- Enter starting dock from lane 7.
- Boats violating the traffic pattern will be disqualified.
- **DO NOT** stop on or near the finish line.
- ➤ Make sure the bow number is properly displayed.

Directions to Lake Natoma:

Highway 80 to Highway 50 to South Lake Tahoe

Take Hazel Avenue off ramp and turn left (north toward river).

Boat storage is at Nimbus Flat State Park, which is the first right turn after the 1st stoplight north of the freeway.
