Entry Info: Entries are due Tuesday October 8 by 12:00 noon on Regatta Central

Entry Rules: Please see OUA Rules and Regulations. Any university entry using fulltime

university students is eligible for full competition.

Progression: Heat winners plus fastest times.

Novice events will race heats only, times will determine overall winner.

Umpires: Licensed Umpires will supervise the races

Meetings: Coaches Meeting: Friday, October 11th @7:00 pm, virtually

Awards: Gold medals will be presented to crew members and coxswains for 1st

place after finals in events with more than 1 entry.

• A coach's only WhatsApp group will be set up for distribution of regatta information on race day.

Weather Contingency:

- Fastest times from heats may be used to determine winners
- If racing is delayed, we may require coaches and other university volunteers to take on additional volunteer roles. The last race must be out of the gates no later than 45 minutes prior to sunset
- Further information about weather contingencies will be presented during the coaches meeting once we know the entries and forecasted weather

Exceptions:

Rule 2.3- Categories of Rowers and Proof of Age and Identity For university events, the OUA requirements and categories will be used, which vary from the categories in the RCA Rules of Racing.

Rule 2.3- Categories of Rowers and Proof of Age and Identity Identification will be not checked but upon request, government or for university events, institutional identification must be produced. (There may be an adjustment for those events which may require ID at weigh-ins).

Rule 2.6- Coxies will not weigh in

Rule 2.10- Lightweight Competitors

An allowance to the maximums for lightweight competitors will be 1.5kg.

Men: No individual rower shall weigh more than 74 kg.

Women: No individual rower shall weigh more than 60.5 kg

Rule 2.11- Weighing of Athletes in Weight Restricted Events Lightweight competitors must weigh-in for weight restricted events that they are competing in, but they do not have to weigh-in as a crew.

Rule 2.11- Weighing of Athletes in Weight Restricted Events
The weigh-in time period will be 6:30am till 8:30am. Lightweight rowers or crews that
exceed the required weight may still race but with the status exhibition.
