COVID:

- All participants of this Regatta must be fully vaccinated and provide proof. (Medical exemptions with PCR rapid antigen testing allowed in consultation with the Regatta Chair)

- **ONLY ATHLETES, COACHES, OFFICIALS, AND ACCREDITED VOLUNTEERS ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THE REGATTA ALLOWED IN THE BOAT COMPOUND AND LAUNCH AREA.**
- Spectators are to remain on the banks of the race course and not approach the Participant area at the launch site.
- Each University will have a designated 'lot' in the boat launch area. All participants are asked to not congregate outside their lot.
- Everyone will be required to be masked on site except when racing or warming up on ergs while in the boat launch area.
- Entry to the boat compound / launch area will require a daily on line screening for all participants.

Weigh In

- A test scale will be available outside bay 4 of the boathouse Friday, Nov. 5th at 8:00am – 10:00am & 3:00pm – 5:00pm for lightweight athletes and coxswains.
- Saturday Weigh in will open at Saturday 7:30am for Lw and 8:00am for LM;
- Sunday 6:30am for Lw and 7:00am for LM
- Deadweight's will be provided by the Organizing Committee for coxswains at time of weigh in.

Warm-up Cool Down Ergs

There will be 18- 20 ergs available for warm-up and cool down under the pavilion near the boathouse for everyone's use. The pavilion only has four foot high walls and a roof so air circulation should be fine.

Athlete Tents

A 20 X 20 tent will be provided to most teams in their lot with some smaller teams sharing a tent. A portable toilet will also be provided for most teams with some small teams sharing.
