DATE: Saturday, October 1st, 2016. Gates open at 6am with races starting at 9am.

EVENTS: GDRA has partnered with Five Rivers MetroParks to offer a 2000 meter head race on the Great Miami River. The regatta is open to high school, college and master rowers and novices. All events are refereed by certified US Rowing referees.

REGISTRATION: REGISTER entries through Regatta Central

- **DEADLINE:** Midnight (PDT) September 29th, 2014
- PARTICIPANTS: Each participant must submit a waiver by the deadline and complete the 2016 online registration at www.usrowing.org or www.regattacentral.com
- **LATE ENTRIES:** Any entry requested after the deadline will be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Director based on the availability and subject to a \$25 per boat late fee. A Late Entry will not be accepted if it creates an additional heat.

COACHES MEETING: Promptly at 7:30am, Saturday, October 1st at the launch docks. This meeting is to review the traffic pattern, race procedures, important safety protocols, and to answer any questions.

 No weigh-in for Lightweight events --- running on the honor system

REGISTRATION TABLE: Registration table will be open at 7am – 11am and located near the boathouse.

- Coaches can pick-up their packets starting at 7am
 - Waivers are required for ALL athletes. Delinquent waivers (not submitted by Midnight (PDT) October 1st) must be turned in to the registration table prior to receiving the team packet.
- If there is an unpaid balance crews cannot race. On race day payment can be made by <u>check only</u>. Make checks payable to GDRA.
- Coaches may obtain and turn in Drop / Add sheets

INFORMATION / RESULTS / MEDALS TABLE: Open 11am – end of race and located near the finish line.

- Coaches may obtain and turn in Drop / Add sheets
- Results board
- Coaches or athletes may pick up their medals for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} & 3^{rd} place for each event

PROTESTS: Any protests of races are to be filed upon race completion to the race referee.

- Coaches may not approach the staff on the docks in regards to protests.
- A decision will be made by the chief referee and/or regatta chair within one hour.

FIRST AID: BOX 21 RESCUE SQUAD will be our EMT's On the Course: Raise a hand and/or grab the attention of to any referee, ranger, or marshal

<u>At the Finish</u>: Row through the finish line area and around the buoy indicated on the traffic pattern map. Raise a hand or call out to race referees, finish line officials or Box 21 rescue squad officers. Please clear the finish line when you are able.

<u>Boat Trailers</u>: will have PLENTY of room this year! Feel free to parked on the south side of Island MetroPark near the GDRA boathouse at 124 E Helena St. See attached map Boat Trailer drop-off is Friday, Sept 30th 9am – 9pm Boat trailers are directed to their locations by GDRA staff.


