Chicago Sprints Team Points Trophy

Points are awarded to the gold medal winning crew of each event based on boat class, as follows: Eights (30); Fours/Quads (20); Pairs/Doubles (15); Singles (10). In events with semi-finals, crews winning silver medals are awarded 75% of the gold points and the losing semi-finalists 25% each. In events without semi-finals, the silver medal winning crew is awarded 50% of the Gold points.

Kuperman Cup

Honors the memory of Yuriy Kuperman, longtime friend and coach of LPBC. Yuriy trained and mentored hundreds of scullers, many of whom achieved success at local, national and international regattas. The Kuperman Cup is presented to the club that achieves the most success in sculling events at the Chicago Sprints.
