



## 2012 August RADAR Submission/ RADAR Small Boat Time Trial Bulletin #2 – August 3, 2012

(additions from Bulletin 1 are highlighted with a yellow background)

For 2012, ROWONTARIO will be using the August RADAR scores as the primary component to determine who will be selected to receive financial support to attend the 2012 National Rowing Championships (NRC) being held November 9-11 in Victoria, BC.

**Athletes wishing to be considered for the 2012/13 OAAP carding program must compete at the 2012 NRC.**

All Ontario athletes are invited to compete at the 2012 RADAR Small Boat Time Trial on Saturday August 18, 2012 in Welland, Ontario on the South Course of the Welland International Flatwater Centre.

The window to submit the erg battery component of the RADAR score is Saturday August 11 to Monday September 3, 2012. All submissions must be made into the RCA Athlete Database.

The %GMS component of the RADAR score will be obtained at the August 18 RADAR Small Boat Time Trial.

Athletes wishing to be considered for funding support to attend the 2012 National Rowing Championships in Victoria, BC are required to attend the Time Trial in Welland to achieve their % of GMS score for the August RADAR. This is to ensure that funding support decisions are based on RADAR scores where all athletes were at the same time trial. It is possible that conditions in other locations could be more or less favourable. Having interested athletes time trial in one location allows for the best and fairest decisions to be made.

All Athletes who wish to be considered for one or more of the following programs **MUST** participate in the August 18th RADAR Small Boat Time-Trial unless an exception\* has been granted by ROWONTARIO **prior to** the entry deadline:

- 2012/13 Ontario "Quest for Gold" Carding **and/or**
- 2012 National Rowing Championships support (additional info on NRC to be released **and/or**
- 2012/13 ROWONTARIO Canada Summer Games Program (selection document released August 3, 2012)

All athletes must be registered with ROWONTARIO and Rowing Canada Aviron\*\* in the competitive fee category in order to be eligible for this event.

\* ROWONTARIO will consider exceptions in extraordinary circumstances on a case by case basis. The decision of ROWONTARIO will be final.

\*\* Athletes who are in Ontario on August 18<sup>th</sup> for academic reasons, but whose home club is based in another province, must be registered with RCA and their home Provincial Rowing Association in the competitive fee category. These athletes will be permitted to compete at the ROWONTARIO Radar Time-Trial, but will not be eligible for Ontario funding or any other Ontario programs.

***Athletes in pairs are encouraged to ensure that their partners are age-eligible if rowing in U23 or Junior categories.***

Lightweight athletes will be required to meet RCA maximum weights (72.5kg Male/59 kg Female)

**Entry Deadline: 12:00Noon, EDT Tuesday August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

Entry Fees: Singles \$25.00 + HST = \$28.25  
Pairs \$50.00 + HST = \$56.50

Entries will be accepted online between July 3rd and August 14<sup>th</sup> 2012.

All entries and payment of entry fees must be made online through Regatta Central.
