Introduction

Thank you for being a part of this year's San Diego Fall Classic. There were many changes last year to the race, including a new course, launching and landing area, and we have moved it from Ski Beach to Crown Point. Trailer parking, boat storage, and warm up pattern are new as well. We have made these changes to incorporate the finish line of the San Diego Crew Classic. This is a great chance for your team to have its first look and get comfortable with Mission Bay and what is to come with the Crew Classic in April 2015.

Categories

- Novice Junior's must have not raced with their team prior to June 2015.
- Masters must be 21 years of age by Dec. 31, 2015
- Masters shall receive handicaps derived from the US Rowing Standards
- Lightweight is defined as a maximum of 160lbs for Open and Masters Men, 155lbs for Junior Men and 135lbs for Women (Open, Junior's, and Masters). No Averaging, no Weigh-ins.
- The San Diego Rowing Club reserves the right to cancel an event due to lack of entries.

Entries will only be accepted through www.regattacentral.com. Please be sure to register before the deadline as entries received after the late entry registration deadline will not be accepted. The US Rowing Waiver is required to participate in this regatta, but not US Rowing membership.

Check-in

Participants and teams may check in at Crown Point from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 14th, and from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. on Sunday, November 15th. All participants must be checked in by 7:30 a.m. on race day

Coaches/Coxswains/Scullers Meeting

Coaches / Coxswains meeting will be held at 6:15am on Sunday, Nov 9th at the Gazebo on Crown Point.

PRACTICE SATURDAY

Trailers will be allowed to park and unload beginning at 3pm on Saturday. Practicing is allowed from 3pm till dusk. Please be aware that we cannot control recreational motor boat traffic, so Mission Bay may be bumpy. The west bay and Sea World Channel are typically calmer and protected from wakes. Saturday Practice will adhere to the normal Traffic Pattern following the Right-Hand Rule, making sure to keep the shore to the coxswains right and the centerline buoys to the left. (Note: The traffic pattern on Race Day will be posted at the Crown Point Gazebo and will be in every race packet.

Results and Awards

First place medals will be awarded to the winning crews in each event.

Results will be posted at the Crown Point Gazebo. 2016 will have medals for 1st-3rd

Boat Storage

Boats being stored at Crown Point Park can be stored on the grassy area north of the finish line, just like the Crew Classic.

Launching/Returning

Crews Launching from Crown Point should plan on launching 30+ minutes before their race. Launching will take place on the beach, there is no dock. Make sure to put the boat in deep enough water so you do not lose your skag. Launching will take place at the north end of the shore while landing will take place on the southern part of the shore, just past the finish line. There may be hoses to wash your boats, please use the water sparingly. Security will be provided by SDRC on Saturday night before the race.

Bow Balls and Competitor Numbers

No shell may be launched without a bow ball. At registration, each crew will be given competitor number bib and safety pins to be attached to back of coxswain and bow seat and a bow number card for the shell. Please keep your bow number, enjoy!

Parking

Trailers parking in the dirt lot next to the northern most parking lot. There are three parking lots for passenger vehicles. Parking is free. The city does not allow us to control parking. No overnight vehicle parking.

Food and T-Shirts

We will have at least one food truck on site from 7am-Noon. T-Shirts will be available for sale on Sunday at the Sew Sporty tent.

Crown Point Park is right next to many residential houses and because of this there will be no amplified sound. Please be aware considerate of noise levels in and around the park. NO DOGS AT THE PARK.


Directions to the Crown Point:

- Turn Left onto Lamont St
- Stay straight at Yield sign to enter the park

From 8 East

- Take the W Mission Bay Dr / Sports Arena Blvd and turn
- Turn Right onto W Mission Bay Dr
- Stay Left towards Ingraham St
- Turn Right after crossing both bridges onto Crown Point Drive.
- Enter Park on Right, 3 entrances to choose from.
